Housing Facility Options BALL RESIDENCE HALL

Ball Residence is a traditional coed residence hall for first year students under the age of 21. Rooms include twin beds, desks & chairs, dressers, closet, & waste baskets. Certain rooms are air conditioned and attached bathrooms may be available. This facility features the Living Your Freshman Experience (LYFE) program, free laundry, supplemental instruction, computer lab, academic support, classrooms, and lounges. Ball Residence closes for winter break. Residents may leave their belongings but must vacate the building during this break period.

THE UNIVERSITY TOWER (Formerly University Place Hotel)

New for fall 2013! The Tower is a traditional coed residence hall for first year students under the age of 21. Rooms include twin beds, desks & chairs, dressers, closet, are fully air conditioned with individual climate control and an attached bathroom. The Tower also includes a fitness center, free laundry, lounge & study rooms, full service dining facilities, classrooms, and Residential Based Learning Community options. The Tower closes for winter break. Residents may leave their belongings but must vacate the building during this break period.

TOWNHOMES AT IUPUI

Townhomes at IUPUI have one double occupancy (shared) bedroom with bunk beds. Two bedroom units have an additional single occupancy (private) bedroom. These units are approximately 650-800 square feet, feature individual entrances, are fully furnished, and include ALL utilities. Each bedroom includes twin beds, desks & chairs, and dressers. Communal living space includes a sofa, entertainment center, end table, and dinette set. Basic appliances include refrigerator, stove and full-size washer/dryer. This community features academic support, social events, programming, and furnished community courtyards.

IUPUI RIVERWALK APARTMENTS

IUPUI Riverwalk Apartments feature private bedrooms within one, two, or four bedroom apartments. These apartments are approximately 500-1250 square feet, are fully furnished and include ALL utilities. Each bedroom includes a full-size bed, desk & chair, and dresser. Living space includes a sofa, arm chair, entertainment center, end table and dinette set. Appliances include refrigerator, stove, dishwasher, microwave, and full-size washer/dryer. The community features a computer lab, academic support, social events, programming, and Residential Based Learning Communities including the Sophomore Year Experience program.

Residential Based Learning Communities (RBLCs)

- LYFE (Living Your Freshman Experience): Ball Residence. LYFE provides programs and services designed to meet the unique needs of first year residential students. Students participating in LYFE will experience success in a dynamic living and learning environment. Along with receiving assistance from LYFE staff, students will have the option to become a LYFE Scholar with increased faculty interaction and a stipend towards next year's housing.
- SYE CROSSROADS (Sophomore Year Experience): Riverwalk Apartments. SYE Crossroads provides programs and services intentionally designed to meet the unique needs of second year residential students. The focus will be on building networks, forming major and career connections, establishing executive decision-making skills, and discovering intentional co-curricular opportunities to enhance the college experience.
- **CHOOSE** (Campus Housing Out Of State Experience): All Locations. CHOOSE is a programming track for residents who are coming to IUPUI from outside the state of Indiana. The focus will be on involving residents in events and activities taking place on campus and in the Indianapolis area. This includes festivals, museums, eateries, sporting events, and exploring the Indianapolis districts.
- FIRST GENERATION EXPERIENCE: All Locations. This track will deliver programming to our residents who are the first in their family to experience college life. How to build a support network, navigate the financial aid system, choose a major that fits you, and how to locate and utilize resources will be a few of the topics discussed.
- ⊯ HERRON HOUSE: Riverwalk Apartments (4bdrm). Herron House provides a supportive, creative residential environment for students who attend Herron School of Art and Design. Herron House fosters academic, personal, and creative excellence by establishing strong ties to the Herron School, IUPUI, and the Indianapolis arts community. - HONORS HOUSE: The Tower and Riverwalk Apartments (2bdrm or 1bdrm). The RA and the Honors College provide support and programming resources for Honors House residents. The Honors College also maintains an onsite office and resident lounge spaces for academic advising, administrative assistance, and special program support for its residents. Regular social, academic events and programming build a strong sense of community and supplement classroom activities. Leadership opportunities such as the Honors House Council, provide for the continued growth and development of the Honors Community. - INTERNATIONAL HOUSE: Riverwalk Apartments (4bdrm). International House is open to students and scholars from all over the world who are selected on the basis of their enthusiasm and potential for contribution to a cross-cultural learning environment and commitment to I-House principles. I-House, along with the International Club, co-sponsors the weekly International Culture Hours every Friday and organize programs on global issues. - KELLEY BUSINESS COMMUNITY: The Tower. The Kelley Community is available to students majoring in business. - PETM (Physical Education and Tourism Management): The Tower.

- PURDUE HOUSE: Riverwalk Apartments (4bdrm or 2bdrm). - SPEA (Justice and Pre-Law): The Tower. Available to freshmen students interested in issues related to justice or law. Students will be encouraged to lead and participate in social justice initiatives and service opportunities on campus and within the Indianapolis community. Common majors might include Criminal Justice, Public Safety Management, Civil Leadership, Management, and anyone who identifies as Pre-Law. - is STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics): The Tower. The STEM Community is a first year living learning community for freshman majoring in the Schools of Engineering & Technology and Science. The living learning community promotes scholarship and camaraderie among first year STEM students. The community will offer activities focused on tutoring, career investigation, social, and first year programs. Students in the STEM community are encouraged to enroll in the STEM Summer Bridge program to enhance their first year experience and membership in the Gateway STEM Community. - SUSTAINABILITY HOUSE: Riverwalk Apartments (2bdrm). This community is open to all students of various class years and majors interested in environmental and social action, education, advocacy, and service. Students will be encouraged to lead and participate in a sustainability focused service project.
